Host families welcome you into their homes, sharing their culture and learning about yours. Joining with other international students, practice the language of España, enjoy activities & excursions with other international students.

Spanish Language + Latin Dance or play golf

Latin Dance: In Salamanca the Latin dance lessons take place in a “disco-bar” where you encounter a mixture of people, including the dance instructor and other students, both Spanish and international. In Malaga you have two choices of the type of dance, Sevillanas or Flamenco.

Golf: In the afternoons you’ll have the opportunity to play golf. Anyone who enjoys golf can participate in this course; play on your own or have instruction, 3 days a week from Monday to Friday. Equipment is provided for students taking lessons.

Language Classes: classes are practical but fun. Creative classroom activities are based on real-life situations and give you confidence to speak in the new language. Reading and writing skills are improved. There are 3 lessons each weekday morning, 50 minutes each, with a maximum of 10 students.

Excursions: Excursions to nearby cities provide that extra element to make your stay memorable and complete. You’ll be able to practice your new language and learn about the history and culture of Spain.

Start Dates: If you have some knowledge of the Spanish language you can start on any Monday (Tuesday if Monday is a holiday), year-round. Recommended start dates for beginners are: January 7, February 4, March 3, April 7, May 5, June 2, July 7, August 4, September 1, October 6, November 3, and December 1.

Beach nearby school

For those who like the sun, the sea and the beach, the program in Malaga, a city on the shores of the Mediterranean Sea, is perfect. Capital of the Costa del Sol, this city hosts tourists from all over the world. At this seaside city you will be in a relaxing environment where you can learn to speak Spanish. With a warm climate year round, you can sunbathe on the beach, take a swim in the Mediterranean Sea, stroll along the seafront, and enjoy water sports and other activities throughout the year, while you are studying.

There will be tours to local historical and cultural sights of Malaga such as La Catedral de Malaga (a Baroque-style Andalusian Renaissance temples which started building in 16th century and still in construction) and Plaza de Toros de la Malagueta (one of the largest bullfighting ring in Spain.) Excursions may also include visits to nearby Andalusian cities such as Cordoba, a World Heritage city, a compendium of history and modernity, and Granada, the last city re-conquered by the Catholic Monarchs in 15th century.

Street of Salamanca

Salamanca is a city famous for its university and cultural traditions. It has a population of 180,000 inhabitants of which 40,000 are students. The University of Salamanca is considered to be one of the most prominent in Europe, and many important historical figures have been associated with the university. The warmth of its people and the open festive student atmosphere of this cosmopolitan university city will make it easy to meet people of all ages and nationalities.

Visiting Salamanca you will discover its charms which enchant the hearts of millions of Spaniards and foreigners alike. At first glance Salamanca fills your vision with the artistic beauty of a grouping of historical buildings and a variety of architectural styles from pre-Roman periods to the most current. Those with a love for history and art will treasure this cultural city.

Excursions may include visits to local historical and cultural sights such as Plaza Mayor (one of the most beautiful and largest squares in Spain), and Casa de las Conchas (House of Shells in Gothic style), and Universidad de Salamanca (a series of university buildings founded in 13th century). Excursions may also take you to cities along the “Camino de Santiago,” the Pilgrim's Road to Santiago de Compostela which became a channel for transmitting culture and art between the center of Europe and northern Spain for almost ten centuries.
