ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: CERTIFIED COPY OF SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA. ALL LEVELS OF FRENCH LANGUAGE, BEGINNERS TO ADVANCED. STUDENTS WILL ARRIVE 1 WEEK EARLIER FOR FINAL REGISTRATION AND PLACEMENT TESTS. Fees include homestay [sgl room/B&B or half board]; application and registration process for the universities; assistance with French administrative procedures; tuition; pre-trip & arrival orientations; emergency medical and public liability insurance; assistance and support throughout your stay from assigned local coordinator; 24 hr emergency number. Not included: your airfare, local transportation, books and supplies, personal expense money, funds for meals not included in your homestay. **Option available: Pick up service.**
